## **Q2. What is the difference between a USA Visa and Green Card?**

**Answer:** The USA Visa is simply a name for a permit to enter America. Visas classify visits as full time employment, short term business or tourism / study and are normally valid for multiple visits to the USA during a specified period of time. A **permanent** residency permit once granted is known as a 'Green Card' (but actually pink in colour), and is the first step to gaining US citizenship.

### **Q3. What are my best chances of getting a United States Visa?**
